


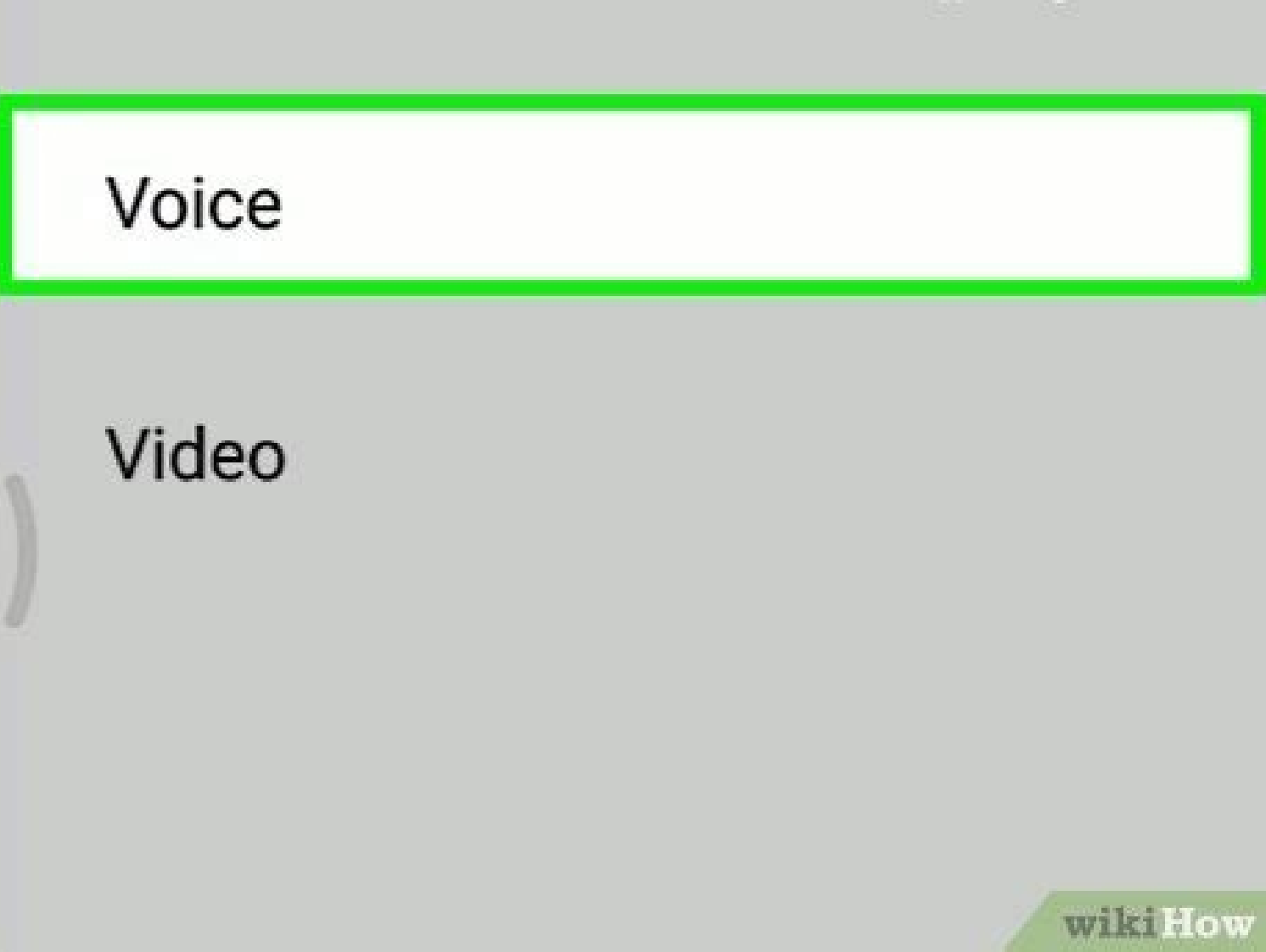
How to turn on voicemail on android

Before the advise of today's high-tech phones, a dedicated landline phone or even a separate answering machine was often required to pursue missed calls. But now you can access your voicemail messages from a device that fits into your pocket! The fact is that this requires preparatory preparation. This tutorial shows you how to set up and operate a voicemail account on your Android smartphone. First of all, we will explain to you how to configure the general settings for your Voicemail account so that it is set up correctly from the start. Then we show you how you can actually get your account up and running. Set up Voicemail on an Android phone 1. Turn on your phone and start the phone app. Turn on your phone and tap the phone app. It is usually in the standard menu on the bottom of the screen. 2. access extended telephony options. In the upper right corner of the screen, click the "More options" button (three vertical points) and then on "Settings". 3. Select to adjust your call settings. Then click on "Connections" in the menu that appears. 4. Select to manage your voicemail settings. Click Voicemail in the Call settings menu. 5. Select which service processes your voicemail, which telephone number is diverted there and which tone or vibration you inform you about the message. In the next menu you can change various aspects of your voicemail. You can select your Voicemail system by tapping service. This can be the standard system of your mobile phone provider or a third -party application you installed. By typing on settings, you can change some of the basic functional of Voicemail, e.g. B. the telephone number you have to call to switch on or access them. Tap sound to choose the sound that is played when you get a voicemail message. You can also set your phone so that it vibrates when you get a voicemail. Simply click on vibrating to activate or deactivate the box next to it and switch it on or off (each). All is well! Your voicemail is now set up as you wish. How do you activate it now? Well, for most Android telephones you have to dial into the account set up by your mobile phone provider. In the next section, we will discuss how this works. Activate Voicemail on an Android phone 1. Turn on your phone and open the phone app. Turn on your phone and tap the phone app as if you want to call someone. 2. Open the key field to enter the number of the Voicemail system. Then tap on the keyboard symbol WOn screen 3. Call the number of your voice mail system or hold the "1" key. Now tap on the numbers on the keyboard to convert the number associated with your secretary account. It can be found in the configuration menu that we talk about when we discuss how to install voicemail. Then press the green call button. Or, if it's really problematic, you can keep the first one. 4. Complete the responder configuration by saving your name, choosing a greeting and setting a password. In short, remember to read what your voicemail can (and can't) do before setting it up. 2. After setting up your voicemail system, verify that it is working properly by calling you. If you're sure you have voicemail on your current phone plan, but you're having trouble accessing or setting it up, contact your carrier. Call them, send them an e-mail. Send mail or check their online troubleshooting guides to see if you can get help or a problem. You can even get help resetting your voicemail password or recovering lost messages. That's all you need to do to set up and activate your voicemail account on your Android smartphone! Next, we will discuss what you need to do if you want to change your voicemail. Click the More options button (three vertical dots) in the upper right corner of the screen, then click Settings. 3. Select to customize call settings. Select the service that will process your voicemail, the phone number it will forward it to, and the sound or vibration that alerts you to the message. Another menu allows you to change various aspects of your voicemail. You can select a voicemail system by clicking on a service. By clicking on configuration, you can change certain basic voicemail behaviors, such as the phone number that will be used to activate or reach it. Click yours to select a sound to play when you receive a voice message. You can also set your phone to vibrate when you receive a voice message. Just press the vibration to check or uncheck the neighborhood and activate or deactivate it (like maybe, maybe). EVERYTHING IS FINE! Voice messages are now customized as desired. So how do you actually activate it now? Well, for most Android phones, you will have to call the account set up by your telecom provider. In the next section, we'll see how to proceed. Open the keypad and enter the Vocal Exchange System number. Then tap the digital coverage icon at the bottom of the screen. 3. Call your voice mail system or just press and hold "1". Now press the keyboard shapes to dial the number associated with the voicemail account. This can be found in the Settings menu we mentioned when we discussed the voicemail configuration. Then press the green call button. Or, if you're putting too many challenges, you can just press the 1 key and keep pressing it. 4. Complete the voice mail configuration by entering your name, selecting a receive message, and defining a password. The process here may vary slightly because each telecom operator manages vocal messages slightly different from the others. However, while the steps and specific execution may differ, the general steps to follow are essentially the same. First of all, you will have to write down your name for the people who callVoice mail, you know who they called. Just follow the instructions you think to register it. For others, you must select a voice greeting. Select a general or personalized greeting by pressing the appropriate button on your keyboard. Then follow the instructions to select or record a greeting. We have a few suggestions for you to follow if you want to record a professional-sounding greeting or if you want a fun one. Finally, you must select the password option. Choose whether you want to lock your voice account with a password, if you have the option, by pressing the appropriate button on your keyboard. (If so, we recommend that you use a password... otherwise anyone who uses your phone or knows your voicemail number will be able to listen to your voice messages!) If you decide to set up a password lock or ask for it to be done automatically, follow the instructions to create and password confirmation. Tips for creating voice messages on an Android phone 1. Check with your courier for details of your plan. Before you try to go through the setup process and activate your voicemail system, make sure you have it! Some carriers may bundle your voicemail system with other cellular services, while others may require you to pay extra to add them to your plan. Review the Corriere contract information that you likely received with your phone or online account from that courier (if you have one) to see if your current plan includes voicemail. If you're still unsure, call your carrier and ask them. Also note that some carriers may offer multiple voicemail options, each with different capabilities and limitations.
