The Balangay Museum Museum, provided by the Coy Balangay Museum, is one of the most popular tourist attractions of Agus Del Norte, which will be loved by history lovers. It is a small open-air museum with one of the nine Balangay, an old wooden ship discovered by local treasure seekers in the 1970s. Monte Hylong-Hilong Hilong-Hilong is considered the highest mountain in the province of Agusan del Norte and the entire Caraga region. It is located at an altitude of 2012 meters above sea level where different types of plants and wildlife habitats can be found in the area. There are 7 known waterfalls on the mountain and an undetermined number of unexplored caves. It requires four (4) to five (5) days of hiking to reach its summit.
